The following services are available to Iowa Department of Health and Human Services (Iowa HHS), Bureau of Prevention, Treatment and Recovery Services prevention contractors.

Capacity Coaching

For the past ten years, the Capacity Coaching Program has served specific prevention grants and now is being offered to all Iowa HHS funded prevention contractors. Any Iowa HHS Bureau of Prevention, Treatment and Recovery Services prevention contractor can access Capacity Coaching services. More information about the coaching process can be found <u>here</u>. Foundational Trainings

lowa HHS is working to expand training services to support the prevention field. Currently, Iowa HHS through partnership with the Midwest Counterdrug Training Center offers Prevention Ethics for Certification Training, Prevention Ethics for Recertification Training and Strategic Prevention Framework Application for Prevention Success Training (formerly Substance Abuse Prevention Skills Training). Iowa Public Health Tracking Portal

The purpose of Iowa Public Health Tracking Portal is to compile important health and environmental information in one place that can be easily accessed and provide necessary data to formulate and enact educated and efficient public health decisions. Monthly Prevention Webinar Series
