There are many benefits that prevention can offer such as offering evidence-based programs, practices and policies.

Prevention practices can include the promotion of healthy coping skills, resilience, and early strategies to address behavioral health issues. By taking an upstream approach to addressing behavioral health issues, prevention efforts can help to promote protective factors within communities which in turn supports the decrease of risk factors associated with serious mental illness, addiction, and related social and economic costs. Investing in prevention not only improves the quality of life for individuals and communities as a whole, it also strengthens public health systems and fosters safer, more productive communities.
